Energy West and DWR conducted a helicopter raptor survey in Crandall and Mill Fork canyons on Monday, May 21, to evaluate the area for the upcoming drilling scheduled to begin on June 1, 2007. Kyle Beagley was the DWR representative, and Guy Davis and Kerry Larsen were the representatives from Energy West.

The nests of concern that are within 1/2 mile of staging areas or proposed drill sites were either inactive or not found (see the accompanying map).

The status of these nests being inactive or not found will enable Energy West to begin staging and drilling activities within Mill Fork and Crandall Canyons on the requested startup date of June 1.

Energy West will stage out of the staging areas in Joes Valley and Mill Fork Canyon to start drilling 1 hole each in Joes Valley and Crandall Canyon. Which holes will be drilled first will depend primarily on water availability at those sites on the startup date.

The remainder of the Energy West raptor survey with DWR is scheduled for Tuesday, May 29.
