I just spoke with Dennis and told him it looked like an amendment. The work will require construction of a structure to support the reclosure switch, which is being installed on the mine's electric lines, not the power company's. A bond adjustment may be needed to cover demolition of the additional structure. Dennis will include language indicting complete as-builts, including this reclosure switch structure, are to come in the future. He also asked that this amendment be expedited so construction can be completed before bad weather sets in, and I told him to include that request, including an explanation of the urgency, in his letter.
