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RE: Notice of Intent to Conduct Minor Coal Exploration (DOGM Task #3337), 2009 Mill Fork Lease Exploration Drilling Program (ML-48258).

Dear Mr. Blake:

PacifiCorp, by and through its wholly-owned subsidiary, Energy West Mining Company ("Energy West") as mine operator, hereby submits two copies of the exploration data obtained from the "2009 Mill Fork Drilling Program" (State Lease ML-48258), drilled in accordance with the approved Notice of Intent to Conduct Minor Coal Exploration (D.O.G.M. Task #3337), including lithologic logs, geophysical logs (compact disk), coal quality analyses and report of water observed. Drilling commenced on July 6, 2009 and was completed on July 26, 2009. A total of two holes were drilled detailing the geologic and hydrologic characteristics of coal reserves in State Lease ML-48258. The following summary outlines the drill hole information submitted along with the hole abandonment documentation:

 Drill hole abandoned utilizing slurry cement/Super Plug pumped through drill rods to bottom of hole. A total of 14 bags of cement, 10 bags of Super Plug, and 10 bags of bentonite chips were used. Brass cap identification marker installed below the ground surface. 40 feet of "H" casing remained stuck in the hole from 10' to 50'. 100 feet of "N" casing remained stuck in the hole from 500' to 600'. All other drill pipe and casing was removed from the hole.

Brass cap identification marker installed below the ground surface. 410 feet of "H" casing remained stuck in the hole from 120' to 530'. 250 feet of "N" casing remained stuck in the hole from 705' to 955'. All other drill pipe and casing was removed from the hole.						

Each of the two (2) sites were reclaimed and seeded according to U.S.F.S. specifications upon completion.
