RE: Notice of Intent to Conduct Minor Coal Exploration (DOGM Task #3337), 2010 Mill Fork Lease Exploration Drilling Program (ML-48258).

Dear Mr. Blake:

PacifiCorp, by and through its wholly-owned subsidiary, Energy West Mining Company ("Energy West") as mine operator, hereby submits two copies on compact disk of the exploration data obtained from the "2010 Mill Fork Drilling Program" (State Lease ML-48258), drilled in accordance with the approved Notice of Intent to Conduct Minor Coal Exploration (D.O.G.M. Task #3337), including lithologic logs, geophysical logs, coal quality analyses and report of water observed. Drilling commenced on July 6, 2010 and was completed on July 26, 2010. A total of three holes were drilled detailing the geologic and hydrologic characteristics of coal reserves in State Lease ML-48258. The following summary outlines the drill hole information submitted along with the hole abandonment documentation:
