**RE: NOTICE OF INTENTION TO CONDUCT MINOR COAL EXPLORATION -  
FEDERAL COAL LEASES UTU-88554 AND UTU-06039; PACIFICORP,  
ENERGY WEST MINING CO., EMERY COUNTY, UTAH**

PacifiCorp, by and through its wholly-owned subsidiary, Energy West Mining Company ("Energy West") as mine operator, hereby submits supplemental information regarding the Notice of Intention to Conduct Minor Coal Exploration - Federal Coal Leases UTU-88554 and UTU-06039.

**1. Hydrologic Monitoring Program:**

In regards to questions raised during our telephone conversation on May 12, concerning adding the proposed holes to the hydrologic monitoring program in the Deer Creek mine permit, Energy West proposes modifying the permit to add the holes to the hydrologic monitoring program only if the holes are successfully completed. The proposed method for drilling these wells is experimental; the probability of successfully drilling into the mine at the desired locations is unknown. If the mine workings are not intercepted by these drill holes, the holes will be promptly plugged and reclaimed according to the Coal Program Rules. If monitoring wells are successfully completed into the mine, Energy West will promptly amend the mine permit to include the holes in the monitoring program as well as the reclamation plan. A driller with a Utah Water Well Drillers license will be present during any well completions.

If the mine permit is amended now to include the holes before they are drilled and the drilling proves to be unsuccessful or partially successful, then the permit would need to be amended again, to include the "as built" well completions or to eliminate them. Energy West commits with this drilling application as with all the drilling applications we have made in the past, that if the holes are completed as or converted to water wells, that Energy West will promptly include them in the hydrologic monitoring program and the reclamation plan for the Deer Creek mine permit.
