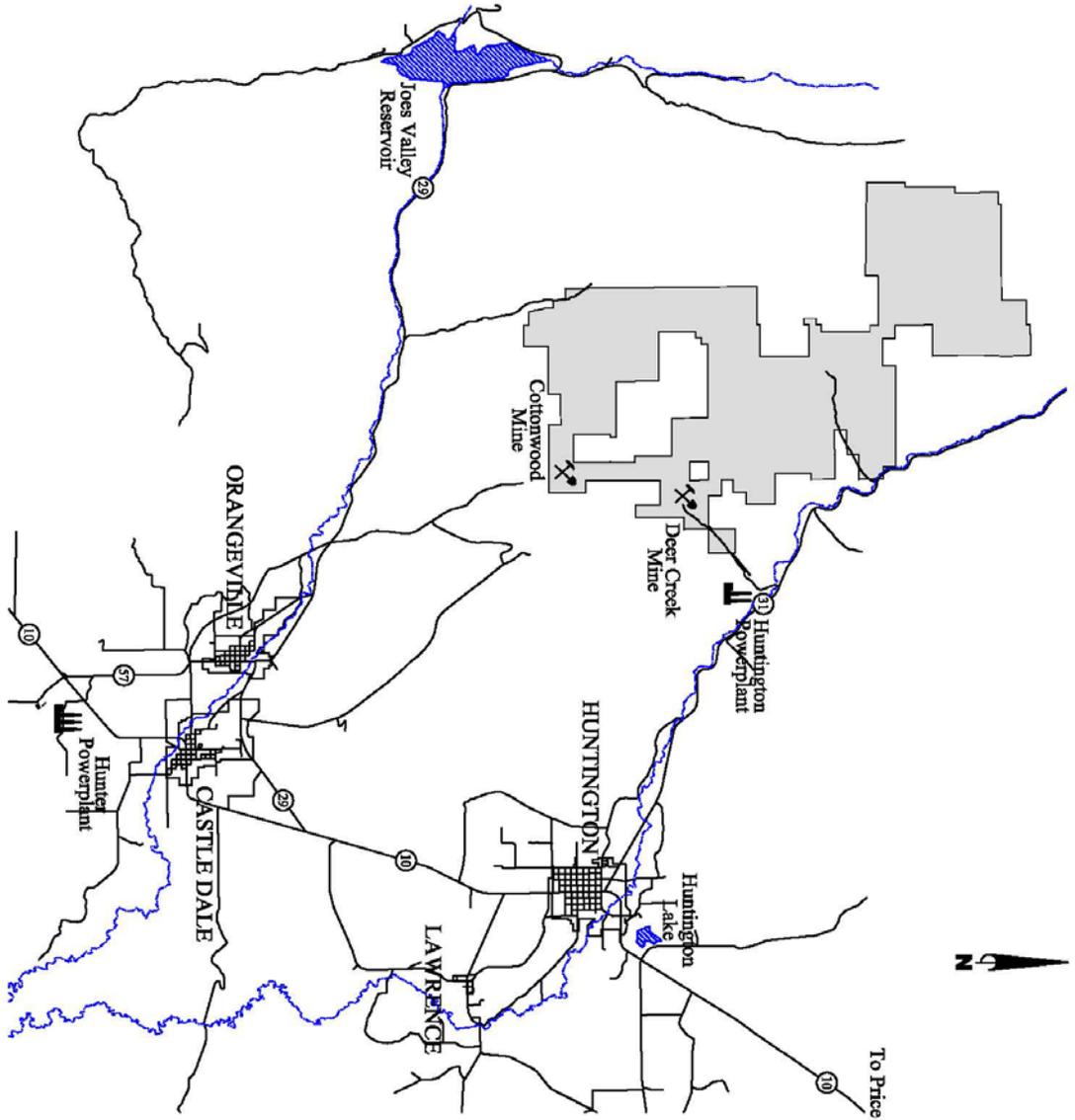

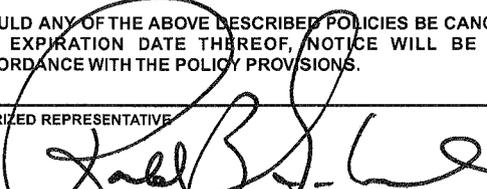

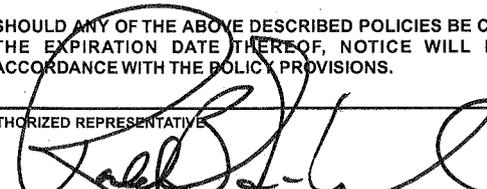

On behalf of PacifiCorp and in response to your letters dated November 8, 2011 and February 1, 2012, addressed to Ken Fleck of Energy West Mining Company, enclosed is a decrease rider bond to Travelers Bond No. 103908970 decreasing the amount from \$4,113,000 to \$3,374,000 together with other supporting documents. This action comes as a result of DOGM's approval to (1) decrease the reclamation bond liability to reflect the as-built Rilda Canyon surface support facilities, and (2) remove from bond coverage and regulatory jurisdiction the Grimes Wash 9th East ventilation breakout portals having satisfied the required final phase II and III bond release criteria for this area

With this transmittal, we are providing the following to update the Deer Creek Mine Reclamation Agreement accordingly:

2. Exhibit "B" (Rider Bond to Travelers Bond No. 103908970 decreasing the amount from \$4,113,000 to \$3,374,000),

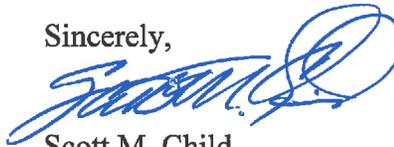

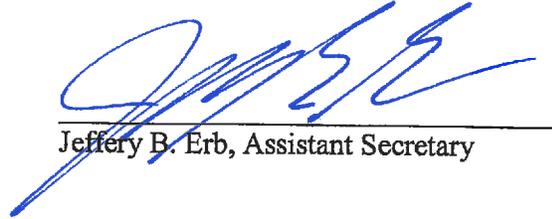
