Operational diversions have been removed and reclamation diversions have been constructed and/or are being constructed.

4.b Hydrologic Balance: Sediment Ponds and Impoundments

The main sediment pond is completely removed, covered with soil, pocked, mulched and seeded. Pictures of this area were taken and are attached to the PDF version of this inspection report.

5. Explosives

Explosive storage area has been reclaimed. There are no explosives on site.

7. Coal Mine Waste, Refuse Piles, Impoundments

There are no remaining refuse piles associated with this site. They have either been sold or reclaimed.

13. Revegetation

The final seed mix is being hydro mulched on to the surface of the reclaimed areas after soil placement, pocking and shredded hay have been applied and incorporated.

Roadways that were the responsibility of the mine have been or are being reclaimed

20. Air Quality Permit


The air quality permit has been discontinued now with the cease of operations.
