Per our phone conversation earlier today, the Division is not proceeding to formal review of the recently submitted Volume 12 Amendment.

Some deficiencies identified during the previous review (#6011) were not addressed with this amendment. The primary deficiency that is outstanding centers on the bonding associated with the Rilda Canyon pipeline.

As we discussed, our normal process for incorporating disturbed area and bonding into the MRP requires field work that cannot be completed at this time due to snow cover.

I'll get with the staff next week and figure out a time that we can all sit down and chart a course through the last bit of paperwork/permitting this is needed for the Deer Creek property. In all likelihood the meeting would take place the week of January 13th.
