Dear Mr. Dewey:

The Division forwarded copies of Utah Power and Light's conceptual plans for sedimentation ponds and drainage facilities to Region Five of O.S.M. for their concurrence and comment. We received Mr. Crane's comments on the plans and we have responded to them. Copies of the correspondence are included herein.

It appears that Region Five of O.S.M. has no serious conflicts with the conceptual plans. Therefore, the Division requests submittal of final construction plans for these facilities. These plans are to be reviewed and approved prior to construction of the facilities. The Division is cognizant of the time limitations due to construction and we will give these plans priority.

Included in the construction plans should be adequate watershed maps, culvert and diversion specifications, runoff monitoring programs for diversions and the sedimentation pond discharge, a runoff monitoring program for the undisturbed area adequate to make comparisons with disturbed area discharges, dam construction details, sediment disposal plans, revegetation plans for cut-and-fill slopes, and the engineer's peak flow and runoff estimation.
