Dear Mr. Thompson,

As you are aware UP&L has submitted plans to bring our Deer Creek, Church, and Wilberg mines into compliance with the OSM's regulations concerning sediment control. As of this date we have only had approval to leave our roads at each mine as they now exist and approval from you on the hydrology calculations for the Deer Creek and Church plans.

We are proceeding with construction of the sediment control structures at all of our mines and we have not yet received approval from the Division of Oil, Gas & Mining or OSM on our plans. The primary purpose of this communication is to remind the reviewing agencies that we are proceeding with construction plans and we need approval of our plans.

I would appreciate some statement as to the present status of the approvals of our plans so that we feel reassured that we are proceeding in the proper direction and that our plans meet the performance standards of the law.
