Standard crested wheatgrass	1
Intermediate wheatgrass	2
Pubescent wheatgrass	2
Russian wildrye	2
Smooth brome	2
Orchard grass	1
Yellow sweetclover	2
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This mixture is recommended to be used with mulch for best results.

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
