
Gentlemen:

Enclosed to comply with the abatement requirements of the above-numbered notice of violation are (1) plans for disposition of excess rock and earth material and stabilization of disturbed area at the Cottonwood Portal, and (2) surface water monitoring plans for Cottonwood Portal.

As I have indicated in the past, we are taking this action even though we challenge the jurisdiction of the O.S.M. over the exploration activities at the Cottonwood Portal and do not intend to waive any rights in connection with that challenge.

We have heretofore posted signs indicating that the activities are being conducted by Utah Power & Light Company under an exploration license from the Division of Oil, Gas and Mining.

If anything further is required by either the Division or O.S.M., please advise.
