On October 9, 1980, a partial inspection was conducted at the Wilberg Mine by Division representatives Joe Helfrich, D. Wayne Hedberg, Tom Portle and Sandy Pruitt. Purpose of the visit was to familiarize the two new inspectors with the Wilberg mining operation and to inspect the progress of the repair and reconstruction to the sediment ponds which had failed in late September.

State officials were accompanied by company representatives, Larry Guymon and Kenny Evert. Division inspectors noted that the inlet to the upper pond is developing some erosional problems and Mr. Guymon has committed to regrading and riprapping the inlet to minimize erosion of the pond embankment.

No state violations were issued.
