Notice is hereby given that the Board of Oil, Gas and Mining, State
of Utah, will conduct a Hearing on Wednesday, June 18, 1980, at 10:00 a.m.
in the Executive Conference Room-Airport Holiday Inn, 1659 West North Temple,
Salt Lake City, Utah, in the above entitled matter, pursuant to the Utah
Coal Mining and Reclamation Act, Title 40, Chapter 10, Utah Code Annotated,
1953.

Notice is further given that the purpose of said Hearing will be to
determine whether or not the Board, after reviewing the facts, shall grant
the company's application for exploration at the Cottonwood Portal pursuant
to Section 40-10-24(4)(c) which provides:

After the effective date of this Chapter and subject to valid existing
rights, no surface coal mining operations, except those which exist on
that date, shall be permitted:

Within 100 feet of the outside right-of-way line of any public
road, except where mine access roads or haulage roads join this right-
of-way line and accept that that the Division may permit these roads
to be relocated or the area affected to lie within 100 feet of the
road, if after public notice and opportunity for public hearing in the
locality a written finding is made that the interest of the public
and the land owners affected thereby will be protected.

Utah Power and Light Company, and all persons interested in said mining
operation located in Township 17 South, Range 7 East, Sections 2,3,4,5,6,7,8,9,
10,11,12,13,14,15,16,17,18,19,20,21,22,27,28, and 29, and Township 17 South,
Range 6 East, Sections 1,12,13,24, and 25, Emery County, Utah, are hereby
ordered to appear at the above scheduled hearing to show cause, if any therebe,
why the Board should not take the action as set forth above.
