A telephone conversation was held between Cris Shingleton of Utah Power and Light and Mike Thompson of the Division on February 25, 1980. Mr. Shingleton stated that the company had purchased seed and was ready to perform the mulching and seeding as specified in the approved exploration plan, and as directed in the February 11, 1980 letter from the Division to Mr. Gurr.

Mr. Shingleton was concerned that mulching on the new snow^{ac}peak would result in the loss of the material. A substantial snowfall had occurred between the inspection of February 5, 1980 and Utah Power and Light's receipt of the February 11, 1980 letter. Mike Thompson told him that it was acceptable to the Division to delay mulching, as required in the afore mentioned letter, until the majority of the snow^{ac}peak is melted.
