
The Division hereby issues approval for the temporary sediment ponds constructed at the Cottonwood Portal with the following stipulations:

1. That the straw bale overflow filters on all ponds be maintained,
2. That the diversions along the bottom of the slope be maintained free of rocks and debris.

Members of the Division's inspection staff will inspect the structures to determine effectiveness and to check on maintenance of those areas of concern listed above.
