The Utah Preservation Office has received for consideration your letter of June 17, 1983, transmitting a copy of the apparent completeness review response for the Wilberg Mine in Emery County, Utah.

After review of the material re-submitted by Utah Power & Light, our office would recommend that the archeological material is adequate for description of known sites in the project area.

Concerning the historic site, the Old Johnson Mine, our office would concur with the determination of eligibility for that site. Our office could find no mitigation plans proposed for this site, or the statement of impact. This question may be considered by the Office of Surface Mining.
