Enclosed is a drawing of Utah Power & Light Company's waste rock disposal site near the Wilberg Coal Mine.

Storage site No. 1 is full and our present needs will probably exceed the storage capacity of site No. 2.

An on-the-ground review with Mervin Miles was held Monday to discuss the possibility of raising the fill height to reduce the acres of land needed. It was concluded from this meeting that a second containment structure, as shown on the drawing, site #2 was included in the original approvals, and it was preferable from the Bureau's point of view to continue as originally planned.

We, therefore, request a confirmation to begin construction of structure No. 2.


Archeological work was completed March 17, 1977, and was filed with the BLM.
