On November 2, 1983, Lynn Kunzler and Pamela Grubaugh-Littig visited the Wilberg Mine to assess the old fan access road for reclamation. Larry Gwymon, Val Payne and Dick Northrup represented Emery Mining Corporation. We toured the area and were shown what the company proposes to do for final reclamation in this area. On the upper part of the road, equipment will be mobilized to reestablish the drainage. A large rock now in the drainage will be moved. A side drainage that has diverted and cut down into the road will be diverted and ripped into the main drainage channel. The main drainage in the upper portion will have the slope configuration as outlined in the original plan submitted in January 1982.

The lower portion of this area will have some hand dirt work done to repair cuts.

The entire area will be reseeded with the original seed mix proposed.
