A partial inspection of the Wilberg Mine was conducted on August 25, 1983 by Ken Wyatt of the Division. Larry Guymon of Emery Mining Company accompanied this inspector. The purpose of the inspection was to follow-up on the Abatement of NOV N83-7-7-1 issued on August 18 at the waste rock disposal facility.

At the time of this inspection the first two parts of the remedial action had been accomplished. The only remaining abatement work to do is the revegetation and reclamation of the first cell and possibly the second cell. This reclamation work should be completed during the next favorable planting season and within 90 days of issuance of this NOV. The 17th of October will mark the 90th day of this NOV. This revegetation work should be accomplished by then and the NOV can then be terminated.

It was noted during this inspection that along the eastern side of the wasterock disposal area, the berm along the perimeter of this area was showing signs of deterioration due to runoff. Mr. Guymon committed to regrading this area to promote drainage and up-grading this berm prior to the next monthly inspection. This area will be examined during the September inspection. No other compliance problems were encountered.
