On July 13, 1983, the Wilberg waste rock disposal site was inspected by Tom Munson, Ken Wyatt and Everett Hooper. The purpose of the inspection was to check on the status of the disposal site construction and reclamation. One disposal cell had been filled with waste rock and covered with soil material excavated during construction of the second cell. The west side of cell #1 seemed to have the topsoil applied and the further east the higher the clay content of the soil material.

The surface layer was found to be very highly compacted and will require measures be taken to lessen the compaction prior to establishing vegetation.

Materials other than waste rock, including vacuum hose, raw coal and asphalt, were being dumped in cell #2.
