On February 16, 1983, the Des Bee Dove Mine was visited by Pam Grubaugh-Littig, Cy Young, Ev Hooper, Tom Munson and Mary Boucek of the Division. The purpose of this tour was to generally acquaint the above persons with the overall layout and operation of the mine prior to their in-depth Apparent Completeness Review. Accompanying the review team were Dave Lof (DOGM) and Larry Guymon (Emery Mining Corporation).

After touring the Des Bee Dove Mine, the waste rock disposal site south of the Wilberg Mine was inspected. Utah Power & Light has immediate need to expand this site and is submitting a modification to the Division to accommodate their needs. Bureau of Land Management has approved their expansion eastward into existing undisturbed areas but will not approve Utah Power & Light's proposal to dispose of the rock in two 4 foot lifts in the existing disposal site at this time.
