Probability of occurrence points are changed to the "unlikely" category since the event, reduced potential for revegetation was limited to that caused by compaction of the soil during the summer month's and is not as severe as previously judged which was judged to be large scale and permanent reduction. Good faith points are awarded for rapid compliance in an easy abatement situation.
