This is in response to your November 5, 1984, submittal of additional information to satisfy the conditions of the Wilberg Mine permit.


1. Condition No. 1 has been satisfactorily addressed.
2. The requirement to provide "a discussion of mitigation measures" as part of Conditions No. 5 and 6, was not clearly presented in our October 24, 1984, letter to you. Condition No. 5 refers to the subsidence monitoring program submitted in your permit application. If you will refer to the language of the original condition, you will see that we are asking in Condition No. 5 that you submit to us a statement for inclusion in the PAP that each annual subsidence monitoring report will "identify appropriate mitigation measures to be taken if significant subsidence impacts occur".

Condition No. 6 refers to subsidence within the U. S. Bureau of Mines study area. As in the case of Condition No. 5, we are asking that you submit to us a statement for inclusion in the PAP, that as part of each annual subsidence report, you will include a discussion of any significant subsidence events which may have occurred. Together with the discussion of significant subsidence events, you should include a detailed description of the mitigation measures which you propose to utilize.

3. Condition 7a has been adequately addressed.
4. Condition 7d has been adequately addressed.
