Regarding: N.O.V 84-2-22-1/Des Bee-Wilberg Connection Road

Following our conversation by phone of November 16, 1984, I made an inspection of the road. There still is some confusion as to the specific areas you are concerned about and what actually should be done to repair the areas. Therefore, a follow-up visit by you or someone from the technical staff needs to be done. As discussed sometime during the week of November 26, 1984, would be fine.

To reduce the costs of mobilization, we plan on doing all the work after we have agreed on our methods of drainage and erosion control. The same type of equipment will be needed to repair the inlets and fix the erosion damage.

Also we request that in the future inspections conducted on our properties be done in the company of myself or my designated representatives. This will eliminate some of the confusion currently being experienced with this N.O.V. and will also satisfy our needs of security.

In light of the need to have additional insight into your requests we request an extension of fifteen (15) days to December 10th, 1984, be granted for plan submission.

Your attention to these matters is appreciated.
