2. Performance Bond No. SL-6356855 issued 9/26/80 to OSM and DOGM for Cottonwood non-use or reclaimed area (\$55,000).
3. Bond No. SL-6388251 issued 11/9/82 to OSM and ODGM for the South Wilberg portal modification (\$70,000).


