A partial inspection was conducted at the above mentioned mine site by Barton Kale of the Division on November 28, 1984. The inspector was accompanied by Ron Hughes of Consol.

Emery Deep Mine is going to experience another layoff. This will reduce the employee roster from about eleven people to six. Mr. Hughes says that he will be filling in on various shifts so that he won't always be available during normal working hours. Division personnel will have to contact whoever is manning the phones if they need to leave a message. Inspection will take place with whoever is on day shift.

Some minor erosion was noted behind the fan. Water runs off the sandstone and channels between the natural rock and the fan. The area drains to the sediment pond after entering the pad area. The operator agreed to create more established, riprapped conveyance for that water such that the erosion threat is eliminated. They have riprap left over onsite and may combine covering the area with drain rock and possibly add some water bars. The operator was informed that if any significant erosion took place at this site they would be responsible for enforcement action.
