The Office of Surface Mining and the Division of Oil, Gas and Mining (Division) have completed a review of the Mining and Reclamation Plan (MRP) and amendments submitted by Utah Power & Light Company for the Wilberg Mine. The regulatory authorities determined the plan to be apparently complete on December 20, 1983. In compliance with Section UMC 786.11(b) and (c) of the Utah Coal Mining Reclamation Act (UMC, Section 40-10-1 et seq.), notice is hereby given to all appropriate agencies having jurisdiction over or an interest in the area of the operations that a complete plan is available for public review.

The Wilberg Mine is located in Grimes Wash, approximately seven road miles northwest of Orangeville, Utah. The following are the legal descriptions of the permit area:

Upon completion of the TA for said plan, a decision will be made as to approval or disapproval of the permit application. No decision will be taken by the Director for a minimum period of 30 days after submission of this Notice of Availability to the appropriate agencies.
