In accordance with UMC 788.12, submitted for your review and approval are 14 copies of a plan which includes locating and constructing a surface storage water tank directly above the Wilberg/Cottonwood Mine on top of East Mountain near drill hole EM-25. The tank will be incorporated with the mine's main water supply system, thus providing a reliable backup water supply to support the water demands of the mine in case of an emergency, be it fire protection or continuation of mining.

The tank will be connected to the mine utilizing 2-6" I.D. pipe casing, leading from the tank to the underground workings. A staged pumping system located within the mine will supply water to the tank from underground mine water sumps.


It is anticipated that 1.9 acres will be disturbed including reconstructing the previous access road that leads to the area of drill hole EM-25.
