The plan submitted by Utah Power & Light Company for abatement of Notice of Violation N85-2-17-2 is adequate to abate the violation as it pertains to redistribution of soil on the affected area of Cell #2.

My big concern at this time is the fact that Cell #1 was to have been totally reclaimed in the fall of 1983 and is now a storage site for riprap. I recommend that the inspection staff research the status of Cell #1 and handle the matter as needed.

Val Payne of Emery Mining Corporation requested a response to the adequacy of the abatement plans as soon as possible. He is planning on doing reclamation work this fall.
