In reply to the Ten Day Notice (TDN) issued on May 28, 1986, by Henry Austin, Albuquerque Office of Surface Mining, the following information is submitted.

On May 21, 1986, Mining Field Specialist Tom Wright received sample results from an inspection conducted on April 16, 1986 which indicated high Total Dissolved Solids (TDS). Research of Wilberg's NPDES permit indicated a maximum limit which had been exceeded by the discharge occurring during the April 16, 1986 inspection. As a result, on May 29, 1986, Field Specialist Tom Wright returned to the site and issued Notice of Violation (NOV) N86-8-9-1, for failure to meet effluent limitations. An abatement deadline of June 5, 1986 was set on the NOV. This violation was issued prior to the receipt of the TDN and should adequately address the water quality violation.
