History of Proposal

A Conditional Approval was given on September 28, 1987 to the guard shack relocation. My review of Utah Power and Light Company's stipulation responses to this conditional approval is contained in this memo.

Analysis

The sediment control measures to be instituted for the guard station area is considered adequate to effectively treat the disturbed runoff from this small area.

Recommendation

I recommend this amendment be approved and those sediment control measures be implemented immediately.
