The Wilberg Waste Rock Disposal site is depicted on as-built drawing CM-10361-WB. This drawing portrays the site as it exists currently. Utah Power and Light Company (UP&L) submitted fourteen (14) copies of this drawing on June 11, 1987, and submitted the same drawing with the September 23, 1987 Mid-Term Review letter to Lowell Braxton.

UP&L proposes to submit an amendment for a new waste rock disposal site during the fourth quarter of 1988. This means that the present waste rock disposal site configuration will be utilized by UP&L for more than a year.

This waste rock configuration differs from the site in the approved permit, i.e., two cells now vs. seven cells originally approved. This configuration does meet the regulations, however (817.21-.25, 817.45, 817.71, 817.101 and 817.112). This waste rock disposal site can be approved as built.
