The Division approves the above-noted amendment subject to the following conditions:

1. Utah Power & Light Company (UP&L) shall include in the maps & text to be inserted into the approved Wilberg Plan, a revised reclamation cost estimate which reflects the demolition and reclamation of the guard shack, area flood lights and power line.
2. UP&L shall include in the maps and text to be inserted into the approved Wilberg plan, the sediment control measures to be instituted for the guard shack area.
