Synopsis

The response to the Initial Completeness Review of April 5, 1989, has been reviewed. The items of concern have been addressed.

UMC 783.21 Soil Resources Information - (HS)

Analysis and Recommendation

The applicant has committed to providing soil surveys and requested chemical and physical analysis of the proposed substitute topsoil. The development of the information will be coordinated with Division personnel.

Additionally, the Great Group classification depicted on Map 2-17 for the Waste Rock Storage Site will be revised to reflect the proper Great Group classification (typical Cryochrepts). Great Group and series classifications will be made consistent throughout the PAP.

The present and potential productivity statement for the soils within the Waste Rock Storage Site has been submitted and is sufficient. This section will be considered complete.

UMC 783.22 Land Use Information - (HS)

Analysis and Recommendation

The land use classification of the permit area has been updated and discrepancies clarified. This section will be considered complete.
