A spring monitoring amendment was received in the Division office on March 31, 1986. Conditional Approval was given on April 28, 1987 pending the U. S. Forest Service's field review during the 1988 field season. After the field review was carried out by the U.S. Forest Service, two additional springs were requested to be added to the list of springs.

On December 27, 1988, a letter was sent to Utah Power and Light Company (UP&L) requesting that they update their monitoring plan to include Alpine Spring and Flag Lake Spring. On March 7, 1989, the Division received the revised monitoring plan which included these springs.

The Division approves the revisions to the spring monitoring plan and with the updates to the text and Map 2-14, UP&L meets the requirements for amending their spring monitoring plan as stipulated by the Division and the U.S. Forest Service.
