Provided also for your information, are copies of sediment trap detail drawing (DS1159C) representing the sediment traps installed at Deer Creek Mine last year. The traps to be installed at Cottonwood will follow this design.

Reclamation costs associated with removal of the sediment traps are estimated to be approximately \$1,500 which is less than 0.1% of the reclamation bond. Therefore, no revisions have been made in the itemized reclamation cost schedules in the PAP.
