NEW RULE NUMBER AND COMPLETENESS ISSUES

R614-301.722.100 Location and extent of subsurface water, if encountered, within the proposed permit or adjacent areas. For Underground Coal Mining and Reclamation Activities, location and extent will include, but not limited to areal and vertical distribution of aquifers, and portrayal of seasonal differences of head in different aquifers on cross-sections and contour maps;

The operator needs to provide adequate information to address the requirements of this rule. The operator should review Utah rule R614-731.213 regarding the determination that the division can make regarding water-bearing stratum and aquifers related to hydrologic balance.
