Stipulations

R614-301-231.300 General Requirements-(HS) Within 30 days of the completion of the initial phase of construction, the operator must submit as-built surveys of the completed subsoil and topsoil stockpiles. Surveys must include the following information: volume of material, maximum and minimum elevations and slopes, cross sections, and all other pertinent dimensions.

Additionally, the operator must amend the topsoil and subsoil mass balance table (Plate 7-2) in accordance with the results of the above stockpile surveys.

R614-301-233 Topsoil Substitutes and Supplements-(HS)
In the event that the mass balance indicates a topsoil/subsoil deficiency, the operator must commit to fulfilling the requirements of this section.
