This Ten Day Notice is being issued to the Division of Oil Gas & Mining for the operator's failure to obtain prior written approval of the transfer, assignment or sale of rights granted in the mining permit. It is being issued following the findings of an Informal Review dated January 14, 1991 by W. Hord Tipton, Deputy Director of Operations and Technical Services for the Office of Surface Mining for Ten Day Notice #90-02-244-6 (TV-1). In that Review, the State of Utah was told that their approval of a permitting action for the transfer, assignment or sale of permit rights was not done according to their approved permanent mining and reclamation program regulatory requirements. An order was issued from that Finding to the Albuquerque Field Office Director to make a Federal Inspection of the permit issued for that mining operation to make a determination if Federal Enforcement action is needed. In addition, the Director was requested to issue ten day notices to address other like permitting actions by the State of Utah by the same operator for other mining and reclamation permits in the State.

This new Ten Day Notice is being issued to the State of Utah for that permitting action. An administrative review has been conducted by this office since the findings and requests of Deputy Director in the Informal Review of January 14th. It has been found that these permit rights have also been sold, assigned or transferred from Utah Power & Light Company through a merger with PacifiCorp, a Maine Corporation into PacifiCorp, an Oregon Corporation on January 9, 1989. In addition, as of October 1, 1990, Energy West Mining ~~Company~~, a Utah corporation was placed by PacifiCorp as the operator of this mine.
