As you will recall, by letter dated February 4, 1992, you requested information for the Cottonwood/Wilberg Mine PAP midterm review. Attached to that letter was a memo from Mr. Jesse Kelley of your staff wherein specific deficiency items were listed. Two of the items (12 and 13) dealt with static safety factors for pond and road embankments as addressed in R645-301-533.100 and R645-301-534.130.

The information, submitted on March 20, 1992 in response to your request, addressed the safety factor items as completely as possible at that time. However, I feel the enclosed information provides a more adequate response to Mr. Kelley's concerns.

Please make the following changes in the pages of text which were submitted March 20, 1992:

Replace pages 3-32, 3-33, 3-52 through 3-55, 3-58 and 3-67 with revised pages dated 12/7/92.


Delete page 3-55.1.
