The mine water discharge line described in PacifiCorp's letter of September 18, 1992 and listed in NOV No. N92-34-1-1 issued October 2, 1992 has been disconnected and is no longer functioning as part of the mine dewatering system. The discharge location and monitoring schedule returned to the approved location and frequency as of October 7, 1992. The temporary discharge line will remain in-place until April 1993 when mining is completed on the west side of 2nd North. The appropriate agencies will be notified if it becomes necessary to reactivate the temporary discharge system and weekly water monitoring will resume as agreed with the Division of Water Pollution Control.
