Re: Notification of "Doing Business As", Permit Transfer Not Required, PacifiCorp Electric Operations, Des-Bee-Dove Mine, ACT/015/017, Deer Creek Mine, ACT/015/018, Cottonwood/Wilberg Mine, ACT/015/019, Folder #2, Emery County, Utah

Pursuant to the letter dated March 23, 1992, from Denise A. Dragoo, attorney representing PacifiCorp, the Division has made a finding that PacifiCorp is not changing its name from PacifiCorp Electric Operations, but simply notifying us that it will "do business as" (dba) other names including PacifiCorp. Therefore, this is not considered a permit transfer. It is the Division's understanding that there are no management or ownership/control changes associated with this "dba" notification.

Energy West, a wholly-owned subsidiary of PacifiCorp, will continue to be the operator of the mines. A 510(c) check was done January 23, 1991 which reflects the relationships of PacifiCorp and Energy West.

It is suggested that all three permit packages insert a letter in the beginning of the plans that explains the "dba" relationships of PacifiCorp, PacifiCorp Electric Operations, and Energy West that may be found throughout the plan.
