**RE: WASTE ROCK SAMPLING AMENDMENT, PACIFICORP, COTTONWOOD MINE,  
ACT/015/019, EMERY COUNTY**

Dear Pamela,

I am enclosing the following revised pages (revised 3/4/93) which, when approved, will replace the pages of the same numbering in Vol. 10 of the permit. An explanation of each page follows for better understanding of the proposed amendment.

**Pages 2-12.1 and 2-12.2**

We have noticed redundant sampling because of the bi-annual sampling commitment which is currently in the permit. PacifiCorp proposes to continue sampling the refuse used in construction of berms for the containment of refuse lifts as presently described in the MRP. PacifiCorp will sample the upper one (1) foot of the leveled lifts when the elevation is within four (4) feet of the final reclamation surface elevation.

Analytical results are proposed to be included in the annual report.

**Page 2-13**


PacifiCorp has noticed redundant sampling during the coal/rock ratio analysis. The same material is being analyzed for several quarters because of lack of material to make additional lifts. PacifiCorp proposes to reduce the quarterly coal/rock ratio sampling to annual sampling.

Upon approval, PacifiCorp will send additional copies of the revised pages.

PacifiCorp requests the Coal:Rock ratio sampling waiver, approved on 12/16/92 for the 4th quarter, be extended to include the 1st quarter of 1993.
