Re: Permitting of Mining Under the Stream in Cottonwood Permit Area and Underground Access Right-of-Way, PacifiCorp, Cottonwood/Wilberg Mine, ACT/015/019, Folder #2, Emery County, Utah

Pursuant to the meeting held on April 5, 1993 with PacifiCorp, the Forest Service, and the Bureau of Land Management, I have discussed how to proceed with the permitting process with Lowell Braxton, Acting Director, for both of the proposed actions.

Mining under the perennial stream within the Cottonwood/Wilberg Mine permit area will be handled as an amendment to the permit. The underground access through unleased federal coal will be handled as a revision to the permit with a public comment period.
