

On December 4, 1992, PacifiCorp submitted an application for an underground right-of-way through unleased federal coal to allow for a physical underground connection between the Cottonwood and Trail Mountain Mines.

With the recent approval by MSHA to allow two-entry mine development at the Trail Mountain Mine and our decision to utilize an overhead tube conveyor (spanning across Cottonwood Canyon) to physically connect the two mines, PacifiCorp hereby withdraws its application for the underground right-of-way.
