Dear Ms. Grubaugh-Littig:

Samples of the Cottonwood Waste Rock Site, Cells 2, 4 and 5, as committed to in the permit, Page 13 of Appendix VII, are required in 1994. Each designated location must be sampled to the maximum depth of 3 feet. The last date of sampling these locations was 1989.

During the 1989 sampling, the drilling was attempted by a gas-powered hand auger. This method was unsuccessful. Therefore, an auger truck was used on the cells for the sampling.


PacifiCorp proposes to again use the same method of drilling that was successful in 1989. Entrance to the cells will be through the north end of Cell 2, as indicated on the attached drawing. The auger truck will have minimal effect of the vegetation and woody plants will be avoided as much as possible. Sampling will not occur if wet soil conditions exist.

This project was discussed with Mr. Malencik of the Division. He also observed the area during his inspection on April 26, 1994. Mr. Malencik indicated that he felt the proposed sampling method would not significantly impact the reclaimed cells.
