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

Dear Ms. Grubaugh-Littig:

Please find the following as a revision to the recently approved cleaning procedure.

The final stages of the sediment pond cleaning usually involves material which is much thicker. This material could be placed directly on the waste rock for drying. Because of a recent lift leveling, area for this thicker sediment is available.

The procedure revision is as follows:

Place the remainder of the thicker sediment on the waste rock just south of the original approved temporary sediment containment area as indicated on the attached drawing.
