Re: **AMENDMENT FOR TEMPORARY PARKING, PACIFICORP,
COTTONWOOD MINE, ACT/015/019, EMERY COUNTY, UTAH.**

PacifiCorp by and through its wholly-owned subsidiary, Energy West Mining Company ("Energy West") as mine operator requests that an amendment be granted to allow temporary parking along Emery County Road #506. This temporary parking area falls inside the Cottonwood permit area, but parking is for employees working at the Trail Mountain Mine. The temporary parking areas are identified on the enclosed 8½" x 11" section of drawing CM-10892-CP, Plate 3-16A.

Energy West has made application and received an approved encroachment permit from Emery County to park on the shoulder of the road. A copy of the encroachment permit is enclosed.

The parking of vehicles within the Emery County Road right-of-way will not impede the function of any drainage control structures used to treat surface runoff from the disturbed areas. The current drainage control structures (rock gabions) will treat the surface runoff from the temporary parking area. The drainage control structures are shown on the enclosed 11" x 17" section of drawing CM-10501-CP, Plate 3-13.

The ownership for this portion of the permit area is held by the L.D.S. Church. A 8½" x 11" portion of the surface ownership map CM-10520-WB, Plate 1-2, is enclosed for your review. A lease agreement between PacifiCorp and the L.D.S. Church allows construction of facilities and any related activity necessary for operation to take place, this includes parking. A copy of the lease agreement is kept on file.

The temporary parking is scheduled from December 1, 1995 through February 1, 1996 and is designed to accommodate approximately ten (10) cars. The cars are to be parked off the asphalt surface and not impede the road drainage system. Garbage and litter is to be monitored and cleaned up weekly.

Since the parking is temporary no permanent changes to the MRP or associated maps are required. The fourteen (14) copies of drawings and information enclosed with this letter are to aid in the approval process.






EXISTING PORTALS




Application having been made by Energy West Mining Company through Val Payne, its authorized agent, with fees and bond being waived in lieu of a letter of responsibility, and the Application having been reviewed and accepted, permission is hereby granted Applicant to proceed with temporary parking on the east shoulder from just below the old cabin site to just below the diesel portal access of Cottonwood Canyon Road #506 from December 1, 1995 to February 1, 1996.

Stipulations:

1. The temporary designated east road shoulder parallel parking zone shall be identified to begin at a point below the old cabin site approximately across the street from the south tipple/yard gate thence northward along said east shoulder past the tube conveyor bent structure ending approximately 120' south of the diesel portal access and crossing where parked vehicles can be reasonably accommodated.
2. No vehicle parking will be allowed at any point situated along the west road edges of the mine property fence and barricade boundary, except for necessary temporary construction activities which shall be adequately signed per MUTCD Regulations. Thru traffic shall not be prohibited nor unreasonably detained.
3. Vehicles utilizing the designated temporary zone (east shoulder) shall park completely off the asphalt surface and not obstruct the borrow ditch.
4. Emery County shall not be responsible for shoulder irregularities or steepness but allows reasonable accommodation per existing conditions except as may be otherwise reasonably improved by Energy West subject to approval by the Road Supervisor or County Engineer. Permission being hereby granted to Energy West to improve shoulder quality and consistency at their expense by incorporating gravel permanently onto existing shoulders, should it so be desired, provided that all workmanship shall be professional and consistent with current road building practice as directed by the County Engineer or Road Supervisor.
5. Because vehicles will be parked on a slope any litter or trash generated from user vehicles shall be monitored and cleaned up weekly.
6. Emery County forewarns Energy West that snow removal processes may cause significant inconvenience to parked vehicles utilizing the temporary parking zone and will not be responsible for same in the performance of its duties.




for the purpose of TEMPORARY PARKING OF AUTOMOBILES






