



**RE: TEMPORARY AUTOMOBILE PARKING, PACIFICORP, TRAIL MOUNTAIN MINE, ACT/015/009, EMERY COUNTY, UTAH**

PacifiCorp, by and through its wholly-owned subsidiary, Energy West Mining Company ("Energy West") as mine operator, has made application to the Emery County Road Department for a Roadway Encroachment Permit. The application requests approval to allow temporary parking of several Trail Mountain Mine employee's automobiles along the eastern shoulder of County Road #506. The enclosed copy of the Encroachment Permit Application provides details regarding the request. Permission to park in the designated area is requested for the period of time from approximately December 1, 1995 until February 1, 1996, as stated in the enclosed information.

Parking will occur within the county road right-of-way; however, all vehicles will be parked off of the asphalt surface to avoid interference with traffic. The segment of the county road is adjacent to the Cottonwood Fan Portal Area, within the Cottonwood Mine Permit Area. The proposed parking location is indicated on the enclosed Cottonwood Fan Portal Surface Facilities Map (Drawing CM-10892-CP, Plate 3-16A).

Parking will be controlled to prevent impacts to the Fan Portal Area and the associated surface drainage controls. Additionally, obstruction of the road drainage system (i.e. parking in the borrow ditch, littering, etc.) will not be allowed.
